

PRECIS OF THE KIRK SESSION MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 1 March 2017

- **Malawi** - An invitation sent on behalf of the Kirk Session to invite 4 people from Chuluchosema to spend about 10 days in Glenrothes, possibly in September, was warmly welcomed by our Partner Church. It has been agreed to reform the Malawi Partnership Group with the specific remit to plan this visit.
 - **Unitary Constitution** – The new groups are in place and it was agreed to circulate an explanatory paper to the membership before a meeting after Church on Sunday, 19 March to vote on the plan. The Stated Annual Meeting will follow on from this meeting. The Trustees will have met on 12 March to adopt the plan and approve the Annual Accounts.
 - **Sharing Stories** – Anne Rennie attended to tell Session about plans by the Churches Together Group to hold a public meeting to discuss the “God Question” later in the year. This will take the form of a dialogue between people from many different backgrounds on the tensions between Faith and Science.
 - **Post of Administrator** – There has been a good response to the advertisement. Session adopted advice from the Law Department regarding all aspects of the appointment. It is hoped to complete the interviews soon.
