

Precis of Kirk Session Business on 7 October 2015

- **Sound System** – The Congregational Board has approved new equipment to the value of £618.44

- **Afternoon tea fundraiser** – This raised a total of £172.85.

- **Bell Tower** – All conditions have now been met and it is hoped that work will begin on 19 October.

- **Harvest Thanksgiving** - £277.70 and a large amount of foodstuffs were donated to the Foodbank. The service had a Malawi theme with information provide for all members to encourage responses to the steps taken so far in the possible Partnership plans. A congregational lunch was enjoyed by 60 people.
