

PRECIS OF KIRK SESSION BUSINESS ON WEDNESDAY, 3 JUNE 2015

- **Sanctuary sound system** – CARTA has recommended a review of the interior of the church, addressing such things as speakers, light shades and cushions. This will be referred to the Board.
- **Social evening for the organisations** – there has been much positive feedback to Rev Cranfield's talk and to the evening in general.
- **Heart and Soul** – Chris, Margaret and Alan gave a lively account of their visits to the event in Edinburgh and encouraged others to attend in the future.
- **Nurturing Faith Group** – it is hoped to start a daytime discussion/Bible study/ fellowship group in September. There is an opportunity once a month on Sunday mornings to meet in the Bobby Brown Room between 10.00 -10.40 for prayer.
- **Community and Wider World Group** – the sponsored walk on 23 May was enjoyed by the groups - Boys Brigade, Glenrothes Ramblers (Strollers) and Weightwatchers - who took part. About £1000 will have been raised for their chosen charities. Christian Aid Week activities raised a total of £1087.41. Session approved the Congregational Profile drawn up to be used in exploring a twinning arrangement in Malawi.
- **Parish Grouping** – The joint Kirk Session Conference on 22 August 2015 at Trinity was highlighted. There will be a workshop on Dementia in St Columba's on Thursday, 17 September.
- **Pastoral Care Group** – there will be an afternoon Communion service, followed by tea, at 2pm on Sunday, 26 July.
- **Summer services** – these will take place at 10.30am in Christ's Kirk on 5 July, in Trinity on 12 July, in St Columba's on 19 July and St Margaret's on 26 July. Transport will be offered from the church car park at 10am.
- **Future plans** – the possibility of a more informal mid - week service followed by the sharing of food is to be explored. A small group will collect ideas also for innovative opportunities to provide fellowship.
