- **Annual Accounts** – These were presented to Session and Congregational Board members who were pleased to approve them before the Annual Stated Meeting on Sunday, 13 March 2016.

- **Sharing Stories** – May Shaw and Mike Hay talked about their many years of service with the Boys' Brigade. St Columba's Company is one of the few surviving groups in Fife. May will retire shortly and Mike asked people to consider volunteering for this very valuable work.
