

PRECIS OF KIRK SESSION BUSINESS ON WEDNESDAY, 6 MAY 2015

- **Social Evening for the Organisations** – this will be held on Tuesday, 26 May when Rev E Cranfield will be the speaker about her experience of Twinned churches. Information about the Session working groups will also be displayed.
- **Jenny Featherstone Appeal** – a total of £646.08 has been forwarded for her work in Zambia.
- **Presbytery Elder** – Brian Lumsden has agreed to continue in this role.
- **MDStaff** – John Hutchison described his involvement with the SU group at Glenrothes High School. Ally Stark sent a report on his weekly work.
- **Parish Grouping** – there will be a joint Kirk Session Conference in Trinity on Saturday, 22 August 2015.
- **Community and the Wider World** – The planned sponsored walk will leave the Church at 1pm on Saturday 23 May 2015. Elders were encouraged to walk to raise money for sending Youth Reps to the National Assembly in August. The small group looking into twinning with a church in Malawi received permission to draw up a profile form to put to Session in June. If approved it could be shared by Alan and Margaret Kimmitt when they visit Malawi.
- **Pastoral Care** – plans for a Precinct Gathering for South Parks on Friday 19, June 2015 were approved.
- **Open Doors** – Session agreed that we should join the Open Doors scheme on 13 September 2015.
- **Messy Church** – after discussion it was agreed to take a break in July and August this year.
- **Stewardship** – a small group will help Alan to prepare for our next Stewardship season in September when the use of Gift Aid will be promoted. £9600 has been reclaimed from the last one and a half years.
